If you meet the **eligibility criteria** listed below you are encouraged to send in your application now. The successful candidate will be announced at the provincial AGM.

Eligibility Criteria:

- GNABC member in good standing for the past two years.
- Registered with BC College of Nurses and Midwives (BCCNM).
- Full time or part time enrolment in a post-basic program or course in a recognized educational institution at the time of accepting the award OR be registered to write the CNA Gerontological nursing certification examination.
- Courses undertaken must be in gerontology nursing or toward a nursing degree.
- Demonstrate an interest and potential in a career in gerontological nursing.
- GNABC reserves the right to publish the name of the successful applicant(s) on their website.
- Priority will be given to first-time applicants. However, candidates that have previously received an award may apply again.
